B. Interim Assistant to the City Manager/Police Lieutenant Ron Reid presented the staff report on the request to authorize staff to submit an amended San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District (SJVAPCD) grant application in the amount of \$98,861.92 for the acquisition of four (4) fully funded 2013 Trikke Tribred Patrol electric scooter vehicles and four (4) partially funded 2013 Ford Fusion plug-in hybrid vehicles.

Council and staff discussion included the reason for the amendment being that all vehicles included in the grant request now need to be plug-in hybrids.
