Right out of briefing officers responded to an injury accident at a major intersection. One party was reported pinned inside a vehicle and was eventually extracted by FIRE. Last night officers towed a vehicle that was found in the roadway unoccupied with a broken steering column. Officers suspected it was stolen, but were unable to get a hold of the owner. It was parked at a tire shop, where it had been left for mechanical repairs and was taken from the parking lot. There will be follow-up to check for video surveillance from the shop at a later time.
