This was a busy night for officers. There were multiple calls holding at the beginning of the shift and the calls for service did not let up when the rain came. During the shift, officers responded to a suspicious vehicle left in the middle of a major roadway. The car had its airbags deployed, damage to the driver's side of the car, and blood on the driver's side airbag. An area search was conducted, but we could not locate the driver. The vehicle was towed from the roadway and a Hit&Run collision is being investigated. Officers also responded to a reported gunshot wound at a local hospital. The patient came into the E/R with a gunshot wound to his hand. He was uncooperative with the investigating officer, and the location of occurrence is currently not known.
