SPECIAL DEPLOYMENT EFFORTS:

1. Coffee with the Chief, June 16, 2018—Chief Amirfar hosted another Coffee with the Chief event. This event is open to the community to come and address any questions or concerns they have about Turlock directly with the Chief of Police.
2. VIPS completed the task of assisting the Post Office with placing informational stickers about how to report damage and/or mail theft on community mailboxes. This project has taken several months to successfully reach every community mailbox in Turlock. Thank you to our volunteers for their great work.
3. On June 14, the Turlock Police Department assisted with the Special Olympics Torch Run. The Traffic Safety Unit and marked patrol units provided traffic control for the group while running through Turlock, and the TSU expended their escort through the county to Ripon.

ANIMAL SERVICES & PET OF THE MONTH:

1. The promotion of \$25 cat adoptions from the month of May was extended through June, totaling with 10 cats adopted to new forever homes.
2. During June, Animal Services' promotion for free microchips for pets totaled 25 pets micro-chipped before July 4. This promotion is extending through the month of July.
3. Officers visited 23 residents for pet license enforcement.

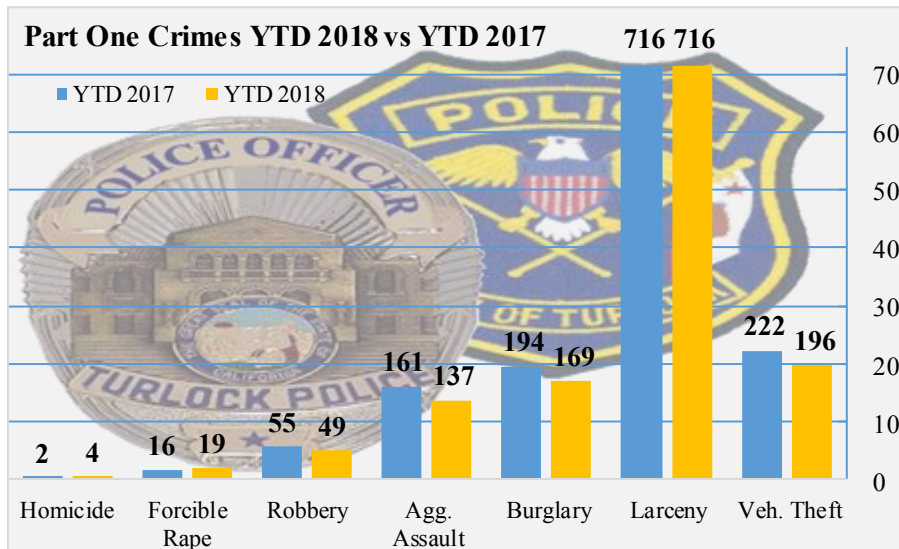

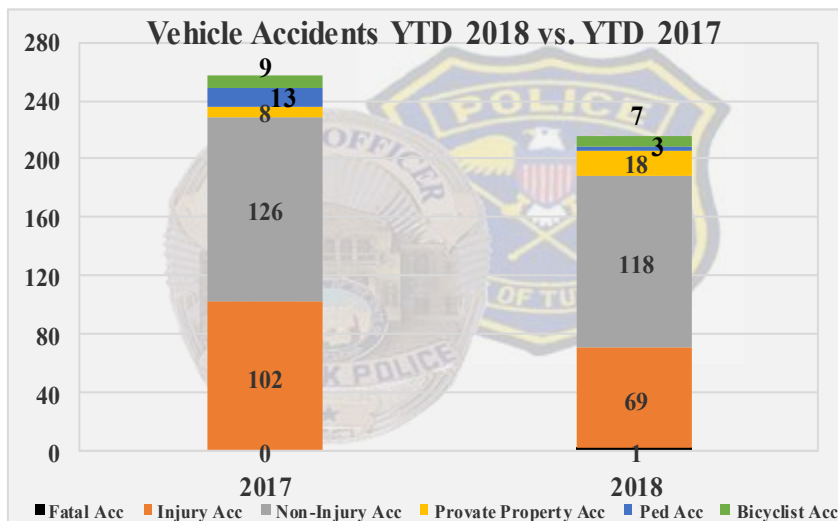
