2. Multiple units from the Turlock Police Department assisted in a large Central Valley wide gang search and arrest warrant sweep initiated by the Merced County Sheriff’s Office regarding gangs, weapons and drug charges. This operation was the culmination of a year-long investigation into the Sureno street gang organization(s). Over forty-seven (47) search warrants and fifty (50) arrest warrants were executed.

PROACTIVE PATROL EFFORTS:

1. Animal Control visited 161 individual residence for proactive license enforcement.
2. Traffic Safety Unit assisted with traffic control for CSU Stanislaus graduation ceremonies that included deploying message boards for traffic information.
3. Traffic Safety Unit participated in a Car Seat Check event hosted by “Keep Babies Safe” at Wal-Mart on Fulkerth on May 26. Approximately 50 vehicles were checked and of those 20 car seats were replaced because they were damaged or unsafe.
4. Traffic Safety Unit focused on pedestrian safety, and issued multiple pedestrian related citations around Lander Ave on May 30.

1. Crime Prevention coordinated / hosted the Stanislaus Regional Law Enforcement Volunteer Academy (10 week program).
